Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) to Host Hole-in-One and Putting Contests at WeaverRidge Golf Club

All proceeds from the fundraiser will benefit CASA of Peoria County.

Peoria, IL, April 21, 2010—Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) of Peoria County will host a hole-in-one and a putting contest at WeaverRidge Golf Club. Hole-in-one qualifying rounds will be held Thursday, May 13 through Saturday, May 15 from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. daily. The five contest entrants hitting closest to the pin each day will qualify as a finalist to participate in the “final shoot out” on Sunday, May 16 at 10 a.m. Finalists will take one shot each at sinking a hole-in-one. The first finalist to make a hole-in-one will win the contest’s grand prize of either \$100,000 cash or two automobiles from Bob Lindsey Acura, with a combined value not to exceed \$100,000.

The putting contest will run the same days and times as the hole-in-one qualifying rounds. Each time a participant sinks a putt, the golfer’s name will be entered into a 50/50 drawing. The winning name drawn on Sunday, May 16 at 10 a.m. will receive the grand prize, which will be one-half of the entry fees collected from putting contestants.

In addition to the hole-in-one and putting contest grand prizes, daily prizes will also be awarded, including free tickets to the LPGA State Farm Classic.

Costs for the hole-in-one contest are: two shots for \$5; five shots for \$10 and 30 shots for \$50. Costs for the putting contest are: three putts for \$5; seven putts for \$10 and 20 putts for \$25.
